

- ★ Shorefishing (In Kensington) is on the open lake and is recommended for adults and those with experience, as the wind and wake from boats can be challenging for new paddlers.
- ★ Single kayaks are suitable for ages 10 and up, 1 person max
- \* Tandem kayaks are suitable for 2 adults or 1 adult and 1 child of any age.
- \* Canoes are suitable for 2 adults or 1 adult and 1 child, with an additional 100 lbs. of coolers or kids in the middle.
- \* Life vests are required and included with the rentals
- \* Dogs are welcome in any boats but there's not much room in the kayak. No refunds if your dog tips you over!
